



Resident Dress Code

While residing at V3 Tucson you will be expected to dress sharp and respectfully at all times. You will be doing your own laundry so you will not have the need for more than one week's worth of clothes.

Clothing:

- Collared Polo Style Shirts (men)

- Blue Jeans (no Baggies or cutoffs)
- Socks and Underwear
- Sneakers/Running Shoes
- Dress Shoes
- Belt
- Sweater/Sweatshirt (No Hoodies)
- Bathing Suit
- Gym Shorts/Sweatpants
- Shorts (For Women no shorter than finger tip length while standing)
- Skirts (For Women no shorter than finger tip length while standing)
- Tank Tops/T-Shirts Men-for work ethic only; Women, straps must be more than 1" wide-no halter tops or backless shirts, must cover torso)
- Dress (Women)
- Toiletries (No products which have been opened; nothing containing alcohol or aerosol allowed). Shampoo and soap will be replenished during the course of your stay ~ special personal items (face wash, moisturizers, etc.) not included.

Other Acceptable Items To Bring:

- Walkman/CD's (one book of CD's only please)
- Journal
- Sketch Pad/Personal Art Supplies, etc
- Laptop Computers (Returned after orientation period) No DVD's
- Camera (No video)
